Purpose	Assessment Test: measures what you know (like a cumulative final)	Evidence-Based Test: measures your ability based on the latest research on the skills colleges value most.
Content	<p>English: grammar, punctuation, sentence structure, style</p> <p>Math: algebra; coordinate and plane geometry; trigonometry (only 4 out of 60 questions)</p> <p>Reading Comprehension: arts, literature, social studies</p> <p>Science: reasoning questions based on reading passages</p> <p>Writing (optional): 30 minute student-written essay (required for UCs and some private colleges)</p>	<p>Evidence-Based Reading: measures skill in reading and comprehending texts across a wide range of genres, purposes, subjects and complexities (multiple choice)</p> <p>Math: measures algebra, problem solving and data analysis and advanced math (calculator portion and no-calculator portion. Multiple choice and student produced responses)</p> <p>Evidence-Based Writing: measures knowledge and skills in revising and editing tests widely varied in purpose, subject, and complexity (multiple choice and passages)</p>
